

# IN THE BEGINNING?

**“In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth”** (Genesis 1:1).  
The Hebrew translation for this same scripture is: **“*Bara Sheath Elohim Shamayim and Erete.*”**

**“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God”** (John 1:1).

**“I am... the beginning”** (The Revelation. 1:8, 21:6).

**“And He is the head of the body, the Church: who is the beginning”**  
(Colossians 1:18).

**“Thou, Lord, in the beginning has laid the foundation of the earth”**  
(Hebrews 1:10).

**“...You have known Him *that is from the beginning*”** (1st John 2:14).

It surely appears that **“The Beginning”** is a Person. He is God, Elohim -- He is the Word -- He is the Head of the Body.

Elohim is Plural.

Word is Plural -- Many words make up the Word.

Body is Plural -- Many parts make up the Body.

The **“beginning”** is Christ with whom you are One. He will bring to your remembrance the things He taught you in the Beginning -- your life is hid with Christ in God before -- (Colossians 3:3).
